TheDream.US scholarships are for highly motivated undocumented students who want to get a college education but are unable to afford the cost. They have no access to federal aid, limited access to state aid, and they sometimes face paying out-of-state tuition. We offer two scholarships.

Denver Scholarship Foundation -

Denver Scholarship Foundation (DSF) offers scholarships to graduates of Denver Public Schools (DPS) who meet eligibility requirements as described below and attend one of DSF's 30 college partners in Colorado. The scholarship is renewable for up to 5 consecutive years. Visit denverscholarship.org/dsf-scholarship for details.

Apply or renew at <u>portal.denverscholarship.org</u>.

To be eligible, students must:

- Attend a Denver Public Schools (DPS) high school for all four consecutive years before
 graduation and be included in the DPS October Count for all four years, unless you
 moved to Colorado during high school. <u>Learn more</u>.
- Graduate from a DPS high school with at least a 2.0 GPA. <u>Learn about the required</u> minimum high school GPA for each college type.
- Demonstrate financial need with a final Expected Family Contribution (EFC) of 16,640 or less. <u>Learn more</u>.
- Complete the FAFSA, CASFA, or other financial aid application as required by your college. Check with your college to confirm which application(s) you must complete and the priority financial aid deadline. <u>Learn more</u>.
- Complete any additional <u>financial aid requirements</u> as determined by your college's financial aid office by July 15.
- Complete all steps needed to qualify for Colorado in-state tuition or state aid. <u>Learn</u> more.
